Welcome to Journey Art! This year is divided into four units that touch on different media in art. I like to start with a basics unit, which helps get kids into the art zone, as it involves some basic techniques and elements of art. This is a great way to review old skills and to get new artists out of their shells!

Bring: 5-6 grade needs sketchbooks, which they will bring every week; the other classes will make paper folder sketchbooks that will remain in my cabinet until the end of the year. All students should come with a paint shirt or smock that they can bring out of their backpack when needed, as we sometimes get messy!

Note: I communicate with parents via a weekly email that summarizes the goings-on in our art room, so please watch for Monday evening emails to get art class updates as well as occasional items to bring from home. Since my syllabus doesn't always go exactly as planned, this will also let you know what projects we're doing when, in case of changes along the way. Also, on April 27th is an art show during our annual Spring Showcase event, where your student's artwork from this year's Journey will be showcased! Save all the art we make in the kids' portfolios, which we make on Day One!
