Purpose:

Music is the expression of the human experience through sound.

We experience music in at least five primary ways...

Listening: In this class, students will experience music by listening to songs from a variety of genres, eras of musical history, and cultures from all across the world.

Analyzing: Students will analyze music by describing what they heard and forming an opinion based on their observations.

Creating: Students will create music by having opportunities to compose short songs or creatively improvise, based on specific criteria.

Performing: Students will experience music through performing (playing instruments, dancing, and singing).

Reading: Students will learn to read basic rhythms, notes on the grand staff, and musical symbols throughout the class. We will practice these skills daily.
